Established in 1955, the Department of Political Science has a rich legacy of academic excellence and intellectual inquiry. Our department offers a comprehensive Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science, fostering a deep understanding of governance, politics, and societal dynamics.

A Story of Growth and Transformation

Over the years, our department has undergone significant transformations. Miss Aloka Bhattacharya joined as first faculty in the department in 1955.

Following Miss Aloka Bhattacharya's retirement in 1994, new leadership was appointed by the UP higher education Commission wide advertisement no. 20 of Miss Rachana in 1996, marking a pivotal moment in our history. Since then, we have experienced remarkable growth, expanding from 50 members in 1996 to 300 in 2006 and 450 in 2011. This growth has been mirrored in our student body, which has also increased significantly.

Dedicated Faculty and Staff

Our faculty and staff are committed to providing exceptional educational experiences. To cater to our growing student population, the Higher Education created a new post in 1998. Miss Shruti Singh joined this post in 2001 but resigned in 2008 to pursue a distinguished career in the Indian Administrative Services.
