#### **About the College:**

A.P. Sen Memorial Girls' College was established in 1902 as Mahakali Pathshala with the aim of providing education to Bengalis in their own language. It was later renamed Harimati Balika Vidyalay. In 1933, it received temporary recognition for High School and Intermediate education from the U.P. Board and was renamed Jubilee Girls School. With the support of eminent personalities like L.M. Jopling (city magistrate) and M.F.A. Richardson (inspector of schools), the institution grew steadily. By 1944, it received permanent recognition for High School education, advanced to an Inter College in 1947, and became a Degree College in 1955, affiliated with Lucknow University. The first principal, Miss Beena Dutta, played a key role in its transformation into a renowned degree college, remembered for her discipline and dedication.

The college benefited from the contributions of notable figures such as Dr. Radha Kumud Mukherjee, Shri A.C. Banerjee, and Dr. Radha Kamal Mukherjee. It was later renamed in memory of Shri Atul Prasad Sen, a poet, educationist, and philanthropist known for his contributions to Bengali Kavya Sangeet and his fusion of Bengali lyrics with Lucknow's Thumri. His philanthropic efforts supported many educational institutions, making him a beloved figure in the community.

- ❖ Font: Times New Roman (English) or KrutiDev 010 (Hindi) with a font size of 12.
- ❖ Word Limit: Paper should be between 2000-3000 words, including references.
- ❖ Structure: Title of the paper, author(s), affiliation(s), contact no, email address, followed by the abstract (300 words), 3-5 keywords, and the main text of paper.
- **APA** style
- ❖ Plagiarism: Papers must have less than 15% plagiarism, ensuring originality.
- ❖ Submission Process: Submit your paper via email to iqacapsen@gmail.com

### **Paper Publication:**

Selected papers will undergo a peer review process conducted by the Editorial Committee. Accepted papers will be published in an edited book. An additional fee will be required for publication, and one hard copy of the publication will be provided for each registration.
